violations reported by NGOs and citizens during the period leading up to the elections, on and after the Election Day, and to include them on a map of Georgia. The webportal's address is <u>www.electionsportal.ge</u>.

The Elections Portal will allow all citizens to report online information about alleged violations and incidents during the period of elections. Further, a toll-free SMS number – 2 500 will be launched, allowing all citizens to send information from any mobile phone network.

The portal is administrated by ISFED.
